By invitation of Bishop Duckworth, St. James Church will be hosting a watch party in Coleman Hall for all Episcopal churches in the Baton Rouge area to celebrate Bishop Rowe's new ministry. Bishop Rowe was elected as the next Presiding Bishop on the first ballot at General Convention this past summer. A Presiding Bishop serves a nine-year term, with Bishop Michael Curry concluding his term on October 31. This is the first Presiding Bishop Investiture service to be made available via livestream.
